Genesis 6v8-8v20

- Noah is one of the most famous people in all history
- Noah is essential to God's purpose in the flood being fulfilled
- Noah's life bridges two epochs in earth history
- ➤ "Noah's life overlapped with Abraham." True or false?

(1) Noah like us (or what we should be)

- found grace
- walked with God
- great faith
- hero who preserved life
- ➤ What did Noah deserve along with everyone else listed in Genesis 5? (e.g. see 6v17)
- ➤ "It is possible to be morally upright and hate God." True or false?

(2) Noah like Adam

- image of God
- represents humanity
- same problem
- ➤ What came to both Adam and Noah (2v19, 6v20, 7v9. 7v15)?
- ➤ Who did God originally command to "fill the earth" like Noah? (Compare 1v28, 9v1)

(3) Noah like Christ

- brings rest
- salvation through judgement
- ancestor of Christ
- ► Do you have Noah's faith?
- ➤ What did Jesus promise to those who came to him? (Matthew 11v28)
- Match the bird with the food: (a) raven, (b) dove (c) dead flesh, (d) living plants

Questions for discussion:

- 1. Why does it matter that Noah really existed?
- 2. What is the significance of Noah's name (5v29)?
- 3. What is faith? What can we learn from Noah's example of faith (also see Hebrews 11v7)?
- 4. Noah was different to those around him in the pre-flood world. How can we resist peer-pressure today?
- 5. What similarities are there between the salvation accomplished by Noah and by Jesus? How does Noah compare to Jesus, the *second* man and *last* Adam (1 Corinthians 15v45-49)?
- 6. Noah was made for a new world (after the flood), but lived for a long time in the old world (before the flood) warning of its destruction. How is that similar to Christians living today?
