- The Bible gives a continuous history from creation to Christ
- Abraham looks back to Adam, as well as forward to Christ
- ➤ "If Jesus didn't physically rise from the dead there is no point being a Christian." True or false? (See 1 Corinthians 15v14).
- ➤ Who does both Mary (Luke 1v55) and Jesus (Matthew 22v32) talk about as a historical person?

- continuous history [1 Chronicles 1v1-27; Luke 3v23-38; Hebrews 11]
- Abraham is as historical as Noah and Adam.
- ➤ How many people are needed to pass a message from Adam to Abraham? (a) 2, (b) 20, (c) 200
- ➤ Whose age at death do we know more precisely? (a) Noah or (b) Jesus?

(2)Linked by promise of blessing

- God speaks life [Romans 4v17]
- undoing curse [Leviticus 26v6]
- promise of a saviour [Galatians 3v8]
- universal
- ► God of creation = God of redemption = Jesus
- ➤ Who are the peoples included in the blessing on Abram (12v3) descended from? (See Genesis 10v32, 9v19)


(3)Linked to us

Questions for discussion:

- 1. Why would many today assume that your faith is irrelevant to them?
- 2. Why does it matter for the gospel that the flood was a global event?
- 3. The blessings God promised Abraham were very physical. How many did he receive during his 175 year life? (See Hebrews 11v8-16). How physical is the salvation God gives to Christians today?
- 4. A Christian says: "Believing in a death-free original creation, a global flood, people living to be over 900 etc. is so ridiculous that it will stop people taking the message we bring about Jesus seriously." How would you respond?
- 5. Our world values equality, freedom and inclusiveness. Where are all these found in the creation and salvation revealed in Genesis 1-12?
